Secretary Report: Minutes were read out loud because no spring minutes were printed. No discussion followed. Mark Schultz made a motion to approve those minutes and Mary Pat Boschert seconded. The spring minutes will be sent home via Family Folder. The minutes were approved and passed.

Treasurer's Report: Edgar went through the budget indicating we have a net income of \$11,877.80. It was questioned what the "unidentifiable" income was. This is money that was either given back to the association by coaches or by Lois Ely without indication of where it came from. In the future any money donated back to the association should be marked as to its intended future purpose (e.g., uniforms, general). It would be best for a coach to cash their payment, and then write a personal check back to the association with its intended purpose. There was discussion about volleyball uniforms. Jeanne remarked that uniforms were purchased in June/July since the price is much lower at that time of the year than waiting until now to purchase. Paul White made a motion to approve the budget; Connie Fiegel seconded. Approved and passed.

Old Business:

*Uniforms: 5/6 grade volleyball uniforms will be replaced next year; 7th grade replaced this year. Uniforms should not be worn for anything other than games; exceptions may be for Catholic Schools Week or High School game night.

*Committees: Always looking for volunteers to help out.

*Points: Given for keeping scorebook, clock, concession stand

New Business:

*Basketball tournament: 7th/8th grade (A league) will be hosted by our school the 1st week in February (M., Tu., Th., F., Sat., Sun.). All parents will be expected to volunteer in some capacity. Much help is needed.
