*Volleyball season: Sign up sheets will go home soon. Still in need of coaches: SKDS will be hosting the tournament. Paul is waiting for dates and then will contact Wayland to see if we can use their facilities.

*Basketball schedule will stay the same as last year. Nick Klavekoske won the Bailey Calvillo Memorial Award, an award for a B-team boy who exhibits outstanding sportsmanship. Congratulations Nick.

*A new school policy encourages the use of SCRIP for future purchases. The plan is to requisition money to purchase SCRIP which will then be used for concession needs or other purchases. Don't expect to be personally reimbursed if you purchase out-of-pocket.

Other Business:

*In the February 2010 school board minutes, there was discussion about a rental fee of \$10 for using the kitchen. This fee is intended to affect those events that significantly utilize the kitchen, such as the stove or dishwasher. Our small events such as the games or dances will not be charged the \$10 fee.
